Fortunately for the USA, NYC will be the 2013 Congress celebrating their 75th Anniversary - offering a 7-Day Cruise to several ports in the U.S. and Canada with an excellent price of around \$1900 congress package price for two people total cost exclusive of airfare with a commitment from the Star Alliance (Delta, etc.) to offer 10-20% airfare discounts.
